

WARSASH MARITIME ACADEMY

Course information - STCW III/1 Engineer Officer of the Watch (EOOW) (Specialised Route).

Certification for candidates with *specialised academic qualifications and/or experience* recognised by the UK Maritime & Coastguard Agency (MCA).

Course description

Candidates will undertake the requisite Workshop Skills training (unless exempted by the MCA), which is taught and assessed to the satisfaction of the MCA in accordance with MNTB standards. Candidates must also pass the initial STCW safety courses before completing a minimum 8 months' sea service within 12 months' industrial experience (including 6 months' engine room watchkeeping duties). Candidates must hold a medical fitness certificate recognised by the MCA. Overseas students are required to meet English language requirements.

During the sea service period, candidates will complete an MNTB Training Record Book to the required standard and complete guided study course material before returning to the Academy. During the final Academy phase, candidates will complete all additional STCW certification courses and attend tutorials prior to undertaking IAMI EK written exams (on General, Steam/Motor and Instrumentation and Control Engineering Knowledge) and the MCA Oral Exam.

Course content (subject to individual requirements)

Workshop Skills Training (completion of MNTB Workshop Skills Record Book) - IF REQUIRED

Guided Study course for General, Motor/Steam and Instrumentation & Control EK exam.

MNTB Training Record Book completed during sea phase.

Statutory STCW certification courses.

Academy tutorials for IAMI EK written exam and MCA Oral Exam.

Start dates (full programme, including workshop skills training)

9 September 2019 13 January 2020 20 April 2020

Duration of course (excluding MCA Oral Exam)

- 1 week at the Academy to complete initial STCW safety courses and MNTB Training Record Book briefing.
- Minimum of 8 months sea service, including completion of MNTB Training Record Book.
- Approximately 7 weeks at the Academy to complete statutory STCW certification courses, tutorials, IAMI EK written exam and MCA Oral preparation, as required.

Please note that an additional approximate 15 weeks at the academy will be needed if the candidate is required to complete the full range of MNTB Workshop Skills Training.
